- The M/s Parvez Akhtar & Sons has quoted lowest rates but due to submission of low quality / sub-standard samples of Towel, Parachute Bag and Sanitary Cloth, the procurement committee decided to reject its bid in the best of interest of provision of quality items to flood effected community of project area.
- The procurement committee analyzed all financial bids where it was very clear that bid of M/s Akash Traders is around the allocated and approved budget in the agreement document. Therefore, the procurement committee discussed jointly and mutually recommended to award contract letter to M/s Akash Traders for the construction of different schemes under the project.
- On dated November 07, 2023, the procurement committee conducted meeting with 1st lowest bidder i.e M/s Akash Traders. The main purpose of the meeting was to clarify to the bidders on the detailed specification of the material and timeline to complete the work.
- The Meeting was ended to and from the chair.
